



About the College

A NUGRAH NARAYAN COLLEGE, PATNA is a constituent unit of Magadh University, Bodh Gaya . It was established in the year 1956 and is situated in the capital city of Bihar. Since then, this institution has developed from strength-to-strength. It is one of the premier co-educational institutions of the state of Bihar imparting teaching to almost Nine thousand student and is serving the cause of education in different ways.

The College is presently imparting teaching in 23 UG and PG Subjects. After consolidating its academic achievements in the fields of Physical Sciences, Social Sciences and Humanities, the institution embarked upon a new venture in the direction of vocationalisation and job oriented education. This College became pioneer in starting vocational courses in BBM, BCA and EWM in 1998. P.G. teaching in Environmental Science, Electronics and three years degree course in Bio-Technology were introduced in due course. The long awaited demand of student of the state for full time MBA and MCA courses was fulfilled in 2004 as AICTE approved these courses. Since then the courses are running smoothly and successfully.

The college has been accorded the status of "College with Potential for Excellence" by UGC and NAAC has Re-accredited this college by awarding "A-Grade".

STATUS OF THE COLLEGE

The College is registered under 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act and is receiving regular grants from the UGC since Fifth Plan period. Hence, the College strictly observes the UGC norms and guidelines in the academic matters.

LAND & BUILDING

The institution has its own campus spread over 13 acres of land. It has constructed 13 large buildings for academic purposes. The college has a very strong in-built infrastructure to sustain the impact of growth, development and academic diversification. With its sprawling lawns, gardens, playgrounds, Common Room, Canteen, Reading Rooms and Library, the institution provides all types of facilities to the students for all round development of their personality.

A.N. College, Patna has distinction of taking lead in establishment of Community College in Bihar. The two new courses are being launched under this scheme from session 2013-14

- Food processing technology.




शुभारंभ

सामुदायिक महाविद्यालय शिक्षा का एक नया विकल्प है, जिसका उद्देश्य शिक्षा से वंचित लोगों को रोजगारोन्मुख शिक्षा प्रदान करना है। शहरी एवं ग्रामीण गरीबों एवं महिलाओं को कौशल आधारित शिक्षण एवं प्रशिक्षण देकर उनके रोजगार हेतु स्थानीय एवं अन्य व्यवसायों / उद्योगों में अवसर प्रदान करने का उद्देश्य है। बिहार में 15 सामुदायिक महाविद्यालयों की शुरुआत की जा रही है। इनमें से प्रत्येक में दो एक-वर्षीय डिप्लोमा पाठ्यक्रम चलाए जाएंगे। इन पाठ्यक्रमों के निर्माण में तथा इनके संचालन में स्थानीय उद्योगों का सहयोग एवं समन्वय प्राप्त किया जा रहा है। स्थानीय उद्योग/व्यावसायिक संगठन न केवल शिक्षण/प्रशिक्षण में सहयोग प्रदान करेंगे बल्कि शिक्षण/प्रशिक्षण पूरा होने के उपरांत सफल छात्रों को रोजगार भी प्रदान करेंगे। सामुदायिक महाविद्यालयों से छात्र, परिवार एवं उद्योग सभी को लाभ होगा और पूरा समुदाय सम्पन्न एवं खुशहाल होगा।

The Community College is an alternative system of education, which is aimed at the empowerment of the disadvantaged and the underprivileged urban poor, rural poor, tribal poor and women- through appropriate skills development leading to gainful employment in collaboration with the local industry and the community and achieve skills for employment and self-employability.

15 Colleges of Bihar have been selected by the Department of Education, Government of Bihar to start Community Colleges in collaboration with Government of India. These 15 Colleges will launch 15 Community Colleges with 2 diploma courses each.



VISION

To promote job oriented, work related, skills based and life coping education, and to empower the underprivileged for employability through Community College.

OBJECTIVES

1. To aim at the employability of the individual trained.
2. To evolve a system to declare the competencies level and duly certify the same.
3. To promote strong Industry- Institutional linkage and ties. It involves the Industry to articulate the skills it wants and work in close collaboration with industries to make the individual skills oriented that is needed by the employer.
4. To emphasise the teaching of the Life Skills, Communication Skills and English to the takers of the System.
5. To lessen the burden on higher Education.
6. To evolve a system of evaluation and assessment of skills, which are personal, social, communicative and creative.
7. To provide skill based, livelihood enhancing education & eligibility for employment to all, without any disparity

FACULTY

The College will provide well qualified regular faculty as well as visiting faculty from renowned institutions for each Diploma Course, In order to provide high quality education at par with national standards, the College will also collaborate with reputed institutes regarding guest faculty.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The infrastructure of the Parent College will be used for running the Diploma courses of the Community College.

PARTNERSHIP WITH INDUSTRY

Courses have been designed and finalized with the inputs received from various industry partners. Industry partners have also agreed to provide internship for the on-job training component of the course. They are likely to employ the pass-outs also.

FEE

- The fee structure per annum for each course is Rs. 6000/-
- The fee for the course shall be charged in two installment of Rs. 3000/- each in July and January of the academic year.



COURSE STRUCTURE

A candidate for a Diploma Courses shall be required to offer and be examined in seven Vocational Content papers and two General Content paper according to the following structure:

Conduct of Examination ::

- The Diploma Course is a full time course of one year duration.
- The University will hold Examination at the end of the year of Course conducted by the Aryabhata University to be known respectively as Diploma Course Examination.
- There shall be a written examination for each of the Theory of two hour duration and one Practical paper of four hour duration. The medium for the written examination shall be English/Hindi.
- The marks for each theory paper will be evaluated for 100 marks carrying 50% weight age for continuous/ internal assessment and 50% weight age for written annual examination.
- In order to successfully completion the Diploma Course, a candidate shall have to secure at least 35%marks separately in the Internal assessment and the annual examination respectively.
- The percentage of Marks required for:
 - a. I Class - 60% and Above in aggregate
 - b. II Class - 45% and above but below 60% in aggregate
- A candidate obtaining 75% marks or more shall be declared to have passed in first Class with distinction.
In order to appear in examination a candidate:
 - a. Must have 75% attendance
 - b. Must bear a good moral character
- Each successful candidate shall receive a Diploma in the prescribed form (as approve by the Academic Council of Aryabhata University) specifying the name of the college and the Diploma Course in which in she/he was admitted.
- Other provision not covered under present regulation shall be governed by regulations of Aryabhata University.
